

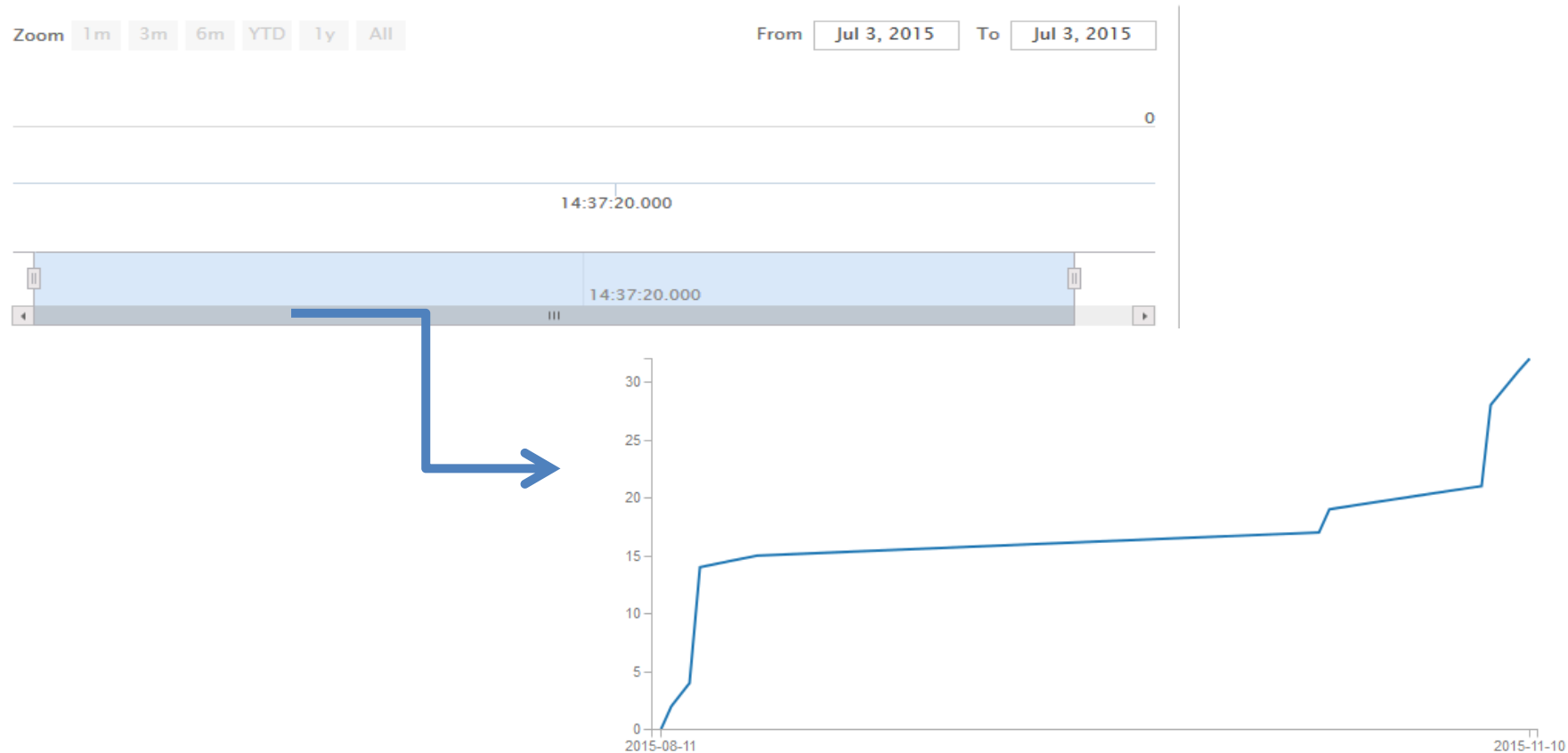

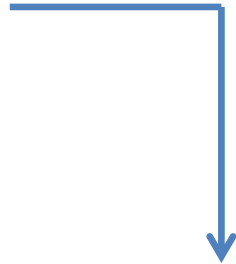

QTAFI questionnaire panel

Question types – Single choice (SC or CV):

Categorizes data into two or more mutually exclusive or contradictory categories such as "male" and "female". Here **only one** variant of response can be chosen

Question types – Multiple choice (MC):

Defines questions with the possibility to choose from a list of given answers as many items as relevant

F3**If you did not search for employment: what were your reasons?**

- Other (please specify):

Question types – Ordinal question (OR):

defines questions which allow to rate the given answers according to a scale - e.g. “Not at all” - “To a very high extent”, “very bad” - “very good”

Question types – Text input question (TE):


characterizes an open question, in which the answers are not predefined – short text as an answer to a question is to be given

Title of the survey, introduction, login field

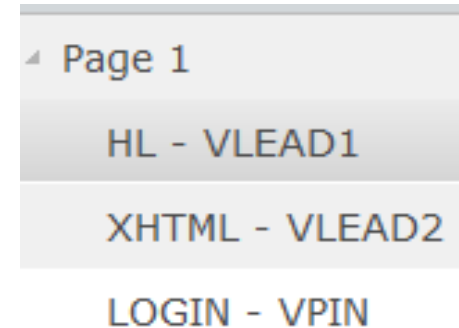
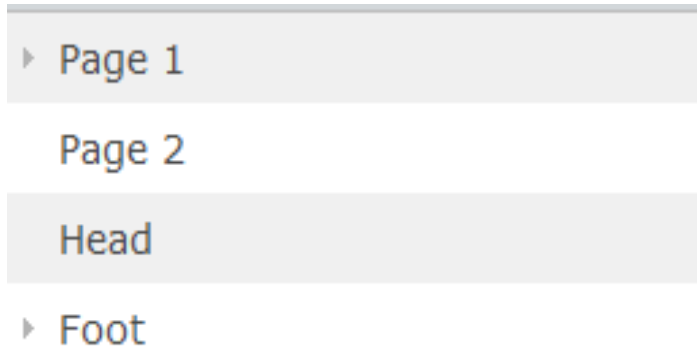
✓ Content page

Can consist of several pages and contains all questions/filters of the questionnaire

✓ Back page

End of questionnaire and gratitude for participation in a survey

Questionnaire structure panel:



- **Add questions/elements to a page within the structure panel**
→ click on a question/element and pull it to a certain page
- **Edit question/element** → double click on the question/element will bring up the question editor window

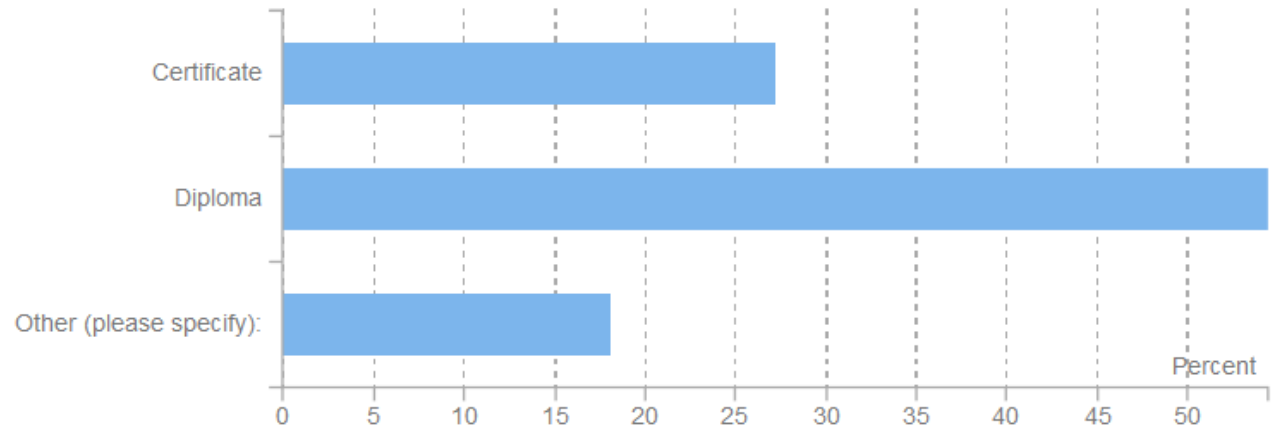
